In Math we are learning to *multiply three digit numbers, estimating math answers, rate problems with a given total and two step equations.*

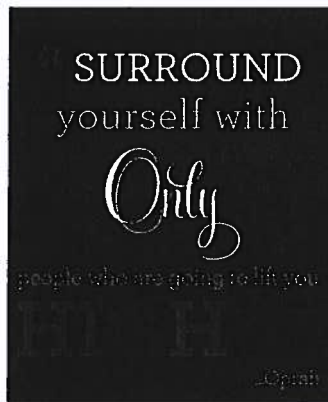
In Science we will study astronomy by looking into the *solar system.*
