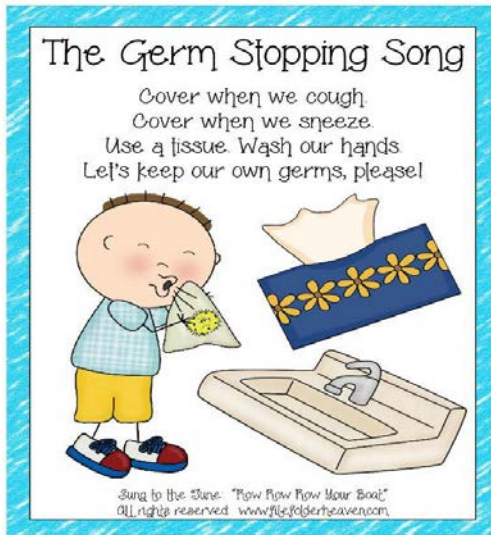
Progress Reports. Please sign and return your child's progress reports as soon as possible.
