by Bruce Lansky

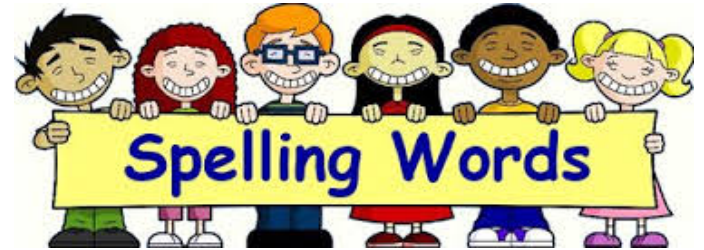
I cannot find my basketball.
