



## Week of September 11th

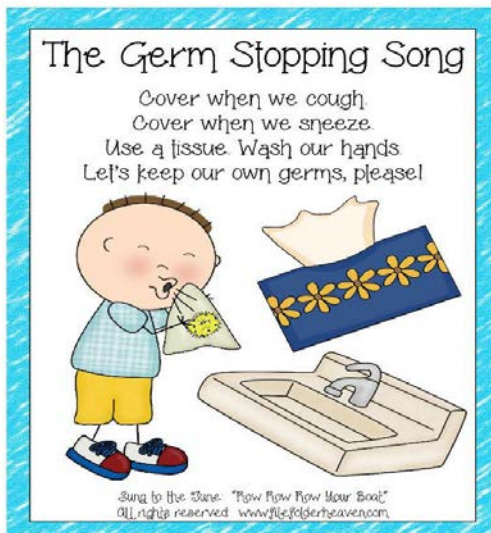
### This week:
