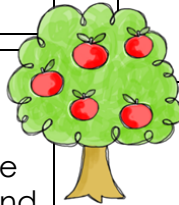

We use y instead of i at the end of a word. (EX: my, sky, and cry make an "i" sound but because English words don't end in i, we write y.
