In Social Studies we will be taking a *Friendship Inventory* and study the *Tepee.*

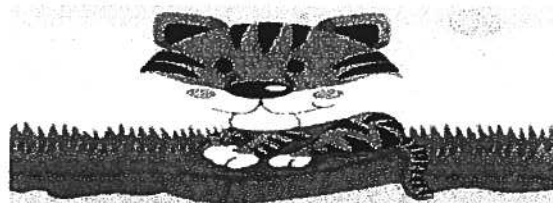
