Arizona reports are coming along.

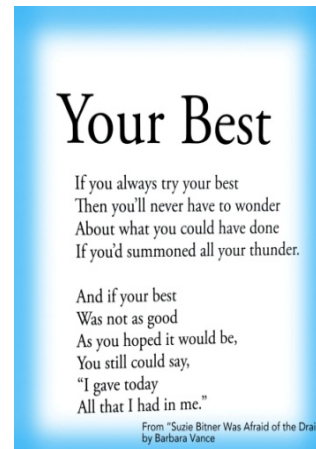
