IMPORTANT REMINDER!

Monday, August 21st, is the Total Solar Eclipse. In Arizona, we will experience a partial eclipse which will begin at 9:13 a.m. and will reach its peak at 10:33 a.m. The eclipse will be over by noon. To ensure that students do not look at the sun, students in Preschool, Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade will remain indoors from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00. a.m. Students in grades 4th through 6th will have the opportunity to view the eclipse through a pinhole viewer under direct supervision. We may have protective welding helmets available to students to use. Classes may also watch streaming video of the total eclipse on classroom monitors.
