Almost all of the weekly envelopes have been picked up, so just about everyone should be working hard. Remember that in the envelope you will find 5 fact quizzes so do one daily with a time limit of 5 minutes and 30 seconds. Next week, we will bump students up to the next level if they were close to passing at their current level. For the reading assignments, continue to use the Open Court book that is already at your house.

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Weekly Spelling words: Thursday, Saturday, admission, canoe, captain, cautious, caution, cellar, covered, creature, curtain, declared, declare, distance, distant, explain, floated, ghost, holiday, holy, public, music, picnic, friend, true, address, struck, getting, whole, hole

In the envelope you will see a group of the fact tests, do one per day, and a Social Studies/Reading packet called the "Netherlands". You do not have to do this all in one day, you can spread it out.

Monday's work: Study Phonograms and Spelling words, Do the Daily Edit Sentences, Spelling 5x each, Adjectives WS 67, Math 109A/B (divide by 1,2,3), Math homework 109B, Reading worksheets 51 and 50 (Cause and Effect).

Tuesday's work: Study Phonograms and Spelling words, Do 5x each Spelling words, Daily Edit Sentences, Adjectives WS 68, Math 110-1 (multiplying by 9), Fact practice 110A/B , WS 110-2 (translate, rotate and reflect). Read Weekly Studies paper and do page 4, Vocabulary Folds (Be sure to use the glossary in Open Court book).

Wednesday's work: Study Phonograms and Spelling words, do Daily Edit Sentences, Spelling Sentences, Math Fact Test 21-2 (5min. 30 sec. time limit), Math test 21, Read in Open Court book pages 156-175 "Butterfly House", do worksheets 58 and 59 (Cause and Effect).

Thursday's Work: Study Phonograms and Spelling words, Do Daily Edit Sentences, Practice cursive capital "P", do Math Fact WS pg 111A/ B, Lesson WS 111 (fractions), and Homework 111B, Reading questions for "Butterfly House".

Friday's Work: Study Phonograms and Spelling words, Do Daily Edit Sentences, do WS 69 (Adjectives that Compare), Multiplying by Four WS, Pictographs WS, Rabbits WS 95 (Summarizing), Spelling Test

Don't forget to read at least 10 to 15 minutes daily.
