Read the book in your packet of "homework"—Yours to keep.

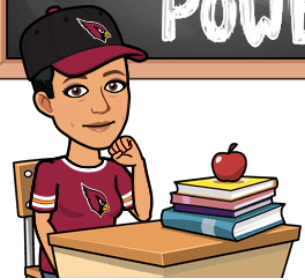
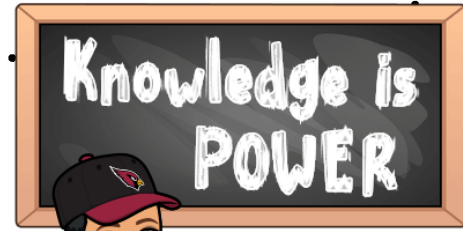
Practice Sight word flashcards as much as you can.
