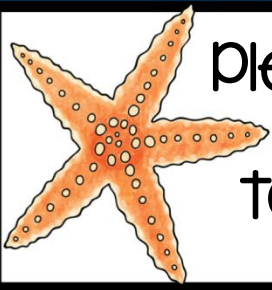

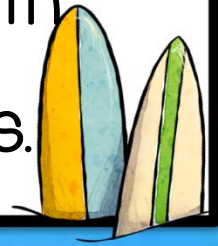

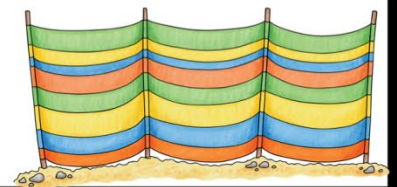
Holiday Party!
