Poem:

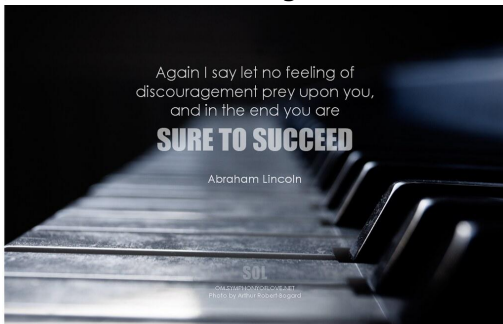
Stopping By Woods On A Snowy Evening
