every day, but the students will need to

practice these at home each night.

## Handwriting: Write will encompass all

letters. Encourage your child to begin at 2

on the clock and go up and over the rainbow

to form any clock letters. Remind the

students that we never begin a letter from

the bottom line. Please practice letter formation at home. The students need practice.

## Math- We will be learning the following:

directions; left/right; same / different;
