Welcome back from Spring Break! I hope it was restful. The big push starts **now** with curriculum. The students are going to be reading, spelling, sounding out new words and growing in all areas. This is an exciting yet challenging time.

We are back with the first 26 phonograms, which is the alphabet. The students will master sounds and letter names and symbols. This is a necessity for first grade work.

We also need to be practicing writing our letters, spelling words and short sentences.

They need to know the number 1- 100, worth, order, big/small < comparisons, shapes, colors. We will continue working on adding and subtracting, grouping and math language.

Please remind your child the importance of good study habits - doing homework and studying their phonogram cards each night. Remember we have started Spelling. Please study the words below each night this week. Test is on Friday!

In class this week:

Spalding - Review of phonograms a, b, c, d.

Reading - We will be reading 3 young readers and group readings. We will be working on word families and patterns in Language & Math.

Handwriting - Practicing with your student writing all letters.

Language Arts - We will continue working on sentences and punctuation. We will review beginning and ending sounds and CVC pattern.

Spelling - Unit 8 (See List). Test on Friday, March 26th.

Math - We will be working with number order, subtraction and working with money.
