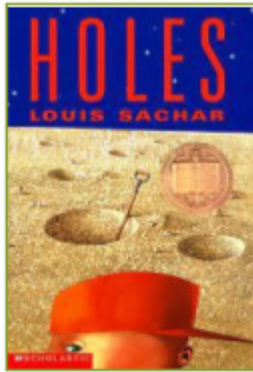
Week of January 3rd- January 7th
