Phonograms:

The students do oral and written phonograms practice daily. The students are doing very well on their spelling and phonograms. Please keep practicing with them at home.

Spelling:

The students have **30 spelling words** each week. Students will have spelling homework:

Monday: Use 10 words in sentence

Tuesday- 5x each 1-14

Wed- 5x each 15-30

Thurs- Write words that are wrong from pretest 3x each

Reading:

The students are continuing to focus on Realistic Fiction this week. We are working on building our vocabulary as well.

Writing/Grammar:

Verbs- helping/linking/irregular
Sequencing events in a story
Transition words

Math:

Students will begin learning about multiples, factors, GCF, LCM
Study Multiplication facts 1-12
HMWK: Study for 5 min Race test on Fridays, Practice Worksheets each night

Science: Big idea 2

Students will continue learning how plants grow, seed disbursement and the parts of a flower.

SS/Geography: Maps/Globes

Students are creating a project to show how to find absolute location. They will be quizzed on the 7 continents and the 4 hemispheres, north pole, south pole.
