### Phonograms:

The students do oral and written phonograms practice daily. The students are doing very well on their spelling and phonograms. Please keep practicing with them at home. **Students will take a practice on Thursday and final test on Friday.** Our Spalding Phonogram Program provides students the tools to improve reading and spelling.

### Spelling:

The students have **30 spelling words** each week. Students will have spelling homework:

**Monday:** Use 10 words in sentence

**Tuesday-** 5x each 1-14

**Wed-** 5x each 15-30

**Thurs-** Write words that are wrong from pretest 3x each

### Reading:

The students are focusing on Folktales this week. We are working on building our vocabulary as well.

We are going to be starting the book How to eat fried worms and doing some thematic activities to go along with it.

### Writing/Grammar:

Verbs/Adjectives

How to write an expository piece of writing. How to eat an Oreo cookie.

### Math:

Students will begin working on Multiplication of more than one digit. We will be learning how to use arrays to help multiply.
