Objectives for this week:

Spalding - Phonograms a, b, c, d, e, f Work on counting sounds in a given word. Writing practice of phonograms.

Reading - Working on understanding that words are groups of letters in a specific order. Each letter has its own sound or sometimes sounds. We will work on how changing the first letter of a word can change its meaning - (cat, rat) / Word family concept or patterns.

We will also start to read words off our Phonogram charts we make in class. These are words the students come up with that begin with the sound we are working on.

Math - Continue working on counting to 20 orally, written # 0-10, Identifying objects 1-10, Sets/Grouping, Equality.

Language Arts - Listening skills, following directions, noun identification,

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identify the setting of a story. We will also be working on learning the poem #2.

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Science - We will be learning about the senses and how important they are to us. We will play a game to have the students identify the different senses.

Social Studies - Continue working on classroom & playground rules. We will take the rules into the community and understand why we have rules.
