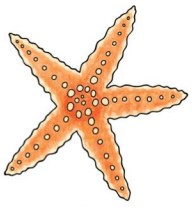

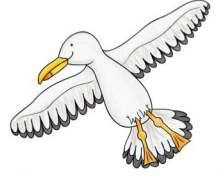

CLASS NEWS

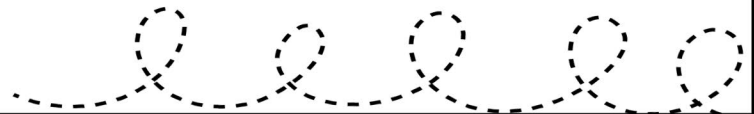


Our class Christmas party will be on Friday, December 17th in the morning. (There is EARLY RELEASE at 12:30 that day.)
