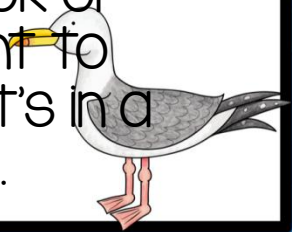

Book Reports

Please have your students practice writing neatly at home, with their letters sitting on the baseline. Also, please make sure they are writing their tall letters tall, crossing their "t" high (not plus signs), and their "r" and "s" letters are not too tall. Thank you! (I take off ½ point for these not being written correctly, as well as capital letters in the wrong places on papers I grade.

Book reports are due once every two weeks. We have fun forms for the students to use for these! Only one student has turned in a book report so far... **these do need to be done every other week.** Your student can use any book or story they want to use, as long as it's in a book they read.



Please do have your students practice writing during our winter break. They need to be practicing writing letters on the baseline, having their short letters all the same height, tall letters tall, "t" crossed above the midpoint (not look like a plus sign), and have their "r" no taller than the midpoint between lines.
