Most of our students have been doing great since coming back from Winter Break

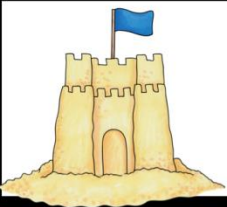
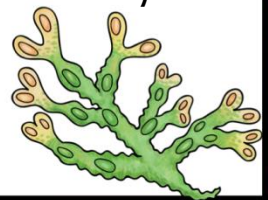
