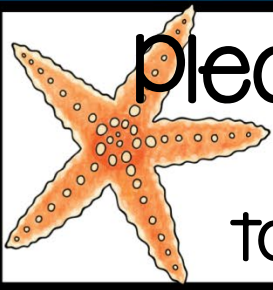

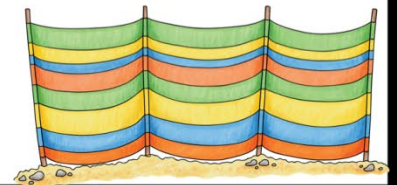
you are awesome
