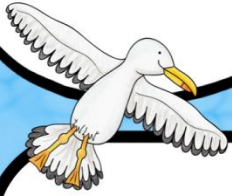

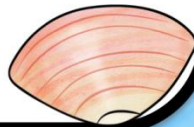
- ➔ **Scissors (if your student does not have a pair at school)**

Book Reports are due EVERY WEEK by Friday morning!



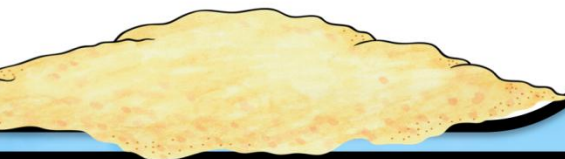
