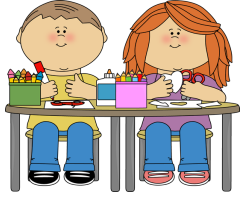


Kindergarten News

Phonograms this week: i, k, l, t

Phonograms to review: a, c, d, g, f, o, s, qu, u, b, e, h, j

Phonogram test over - a, c, d, f, g, o, qu, s, u

Poem “ #2 “ - Please study with your child. We will work 2 weeks on this.

Objectives for this week:

Spalding - Phonograms i, k, l, t. Work on counting sounds in a given word. Writing practice of phonograms.

Reading - Working on understanding that words are groups of letters in a specific order. Each letter has its own sound or sometimes sounds. We will work on how changing the first letter of a word can change its meaning - (cat, rat) / Word family concept or patterns.

We will also start to read words off our Phonogram charts we make in class. These are words the students come up with that begin with the sound we are working on.

Math - Continue working on counting to 30 orally, written # 0-10, Identifying objects 1-10, Sets/Grouping, Equality, Adding 2 numbers (visually).

Language Arts - Listening skills, following directions, noun identification, identify the setting of a story. We will also be working on learning the poem #2.

Science - We will be learning about the human body. They need to know names and placement. We play a game to help with this along with the story, “ Look at me grow”.

Social Studies - Continue working on classroom & playground rules. We have to wear our face masks or Shields in class and around school to help everyone. Focus will be “Respect”.
